This year the cost to attend JALT2020 is well below the regular rate for JALT's annual international conference and attendees do not need to pay extra for the Technology in Teaching Workshops.

Conference rates:

8,000 yen for presenters and participants who are not members of JALT
5,000 yen for presenters and participants who are JALT members whose membership is valid through 30 November 2020. This rate is also valid for ETA-ROC (Taiwan JALT Partner) and KOTESOL (South Korean JALT Partner) members.

2,000 yen for Global Professionals for presenters and participants. Nationals of the countries listed on the conference website who are currently residing in the country of their nationality are applicable for this discount.

2,000 yen for full-time students, as well as for seniors who are JALT members.
